Objectives and Investment Policy

Franklin Innovation Fund (the “Fund”) investment objective is to seek long-term investment growth, through growth of capital.

Investment Policy

The Fund mainly invests in equities of companies of any market capitalisation that are leaders in innovation, take advantage of new technologies, have superior management and benefit from changing economic trends. This may include information technology, software, internet, health care and biotechnology. These investments may be from anywhere in the world but may have a substantial part in companies located or traded in the US.

Strategy The investment manager uses Fundamental analysis to select companies that appear to have high and sustainable growth prospects.

SFDR category Article 8 (promotes environmental and/or social characteristics under EU regulations).

The investment manager applies a proprietary rating methodology using various ESG criteria to assess long-term opportunities and risks. The Fund favours companies with a high or improving profile and excludes or restricts investments in certain industries that are harmful to the environment or society, such as thermal coal, weapons and tobacco. The investment manager engages in dialogue with companies concerning ESG issues.

Product availability The Fund is available to all investors with at least basic investment knowledge, through a wide range of distribution channels, with or without the need for advice.

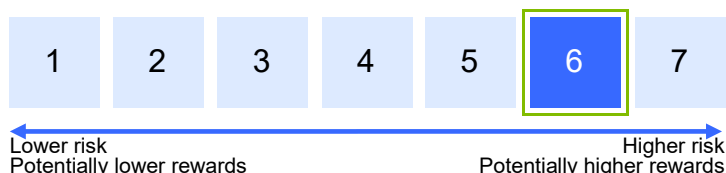
Terms to Understand

Why is the Fund in this specific category?

The Fund invests mainly in equity securities of companies that are leaders of innovation, in the estimation of the manager. Such securities have historically been subject to significant price movements that may occur suddenly due to market or company-specific factors. As a result, the performance of the Fund can fluctuate significantly over relatively short time periods.

Risks materially relevant not adequately captured by the indicator:

Concentration risk: the risk that arises when a fund invests in relatively few holdings, few sectors or a restricted geographic area. Performance may be more volatile than a fund with a greater number of securities.

Equity risk: prices of equities may be affected by factors such as economic, political, market, and issuer-specific changes. Such changes may adversely affect the value of the equities regardless of company-specific performance.
