Objectives and Investment Policy

Franklin Technology Fund (the "Fund") investment objective is to seek long-term investment growth, mainly through growth of capital.

Investment Policy

The Fund mainly invests in equities of companies of any market capitalisation in technology sectors, such as computers and electronic components, information technology, internet, telecommunications, and media and information services. These investments may be from anywhere

These investments may include depositary receipts. To a lesser extent, the Fund may invest in corporate bonds, private companies, private investments in public equity (PIPEs) and special purpose acquisition companies (SPACs).

Strategy The investment manager uses Fundamental analysis of companies and considerations of global technology trends to select companies that appear to have high quality management, a strong market positioning and high or rising profitability.

SFDR category Article 8 (promotes environmental and/or social characteristics under EU regulations).

The investment manager applies a proprietary rating methodology using various ESG criteria to assess long-term opportunities and risks. The Fund favours issuers with a high or improving profile and excludes or restricts investments in certain industries that are harmful to the environment or society, such as thermal coal, weapons and tobacco. The investment manager engages in dialogue with companies concerning ESG issues.


depositary receipts: Certificates of ownership that allow shares to trade in markets where they are not registered.


